## Player Thumbnails

The April issue included thumbnails descriptions of 2004 graduates. This section includes thumbnails for underclassmen plus 2004 graduates who were not included in the April issue. Players are listed by graduating class and then alphabetically within three categories. The first category includes only those players who are considered to have Division IA potential. The second category includes those players who are considered to have the potential to have Division IAA potential. The final category includes those players who have Division II or Division III potential. The placement of players within these categories is based principally on information provided by local high school coaches. WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS does not scout these players and does not render an independent opinion.

One note before moving onto the thumbnails. In the April issue it was reported that two Burrell High School players (Craig Canfield and Nick Mangini) were probably headed to IUP. That turns out not to be the case and both are still open on their college choices. Craig finished the season with a 5-2 record and fanned 48 batters in 33 innings. Nick rebounded from a slow start to hit .330 with 4 HRs.

## 2004 GRADUATES

### DIVISION IA PROSPECTS

#### **Colby Beeson, C, 6-1 210, Neshannock HS, R/R**

Moved from Monte Vista HS in Northern California in December 2003 so he was an unknown in western PA circles going into the season...excellent abilities...hits for average (close to .500 this season) and for power (5 HRs)...runs well for his position...a good defensive catcher with a strong arm...could be a real find.

#### **Eric McGough, P/1B, 6-4 180, Plum HS, R/R**

A power pitcher...throws in the mid to upper 80s...also throws curve ball and a change-up...6-2 record with 66 Ks and only around 10 BBs in 50ish IP...3 year starter...potential to put on much more weight and improve his pitch speed...also plays basketball.

#### **Jason Schmeidel, 3B/SS/P, 6-5 190, Plum HS, R/R**

Tall for an infielder but is a very good defensive player...also #2 pitcher on a highly rated team but future looks to be as a position player...excellent curve from the mound but throws harder from SS than he does as a pitcher...a line drive hitter who has some pop...doesn't strike out much...should show more power as he develops physically...3 year starter...made Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section as an infielder after junior season.

#### **Mark Tanner, P, 6-2 170, Neshannock HS, L/L**

Has been dominant at the Class A level of competition...8-1 record, ERA less than 1.00 and 76 Ks with mid-40s IP...was 7-1 as a junior...throws in the 83-88 MPH range...has lettered since his sophomore year...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section after his junior season...a coach from the University of Kentucky was at his last game

### DIVISION IAA PROSPECTS

#### **A J Bonetto, C/P, 5-11 180, Plum HS, R/R**

Three year starter and two year captain...line driver hitter batting around .400...great defensive catcher...blocks pitches well and an excellent arm...also a good pitcher but has cut back on pitching due to his value as a position player...just does everything well...named to the Pittsburgh Tribune-Review East Baseball and Valley News Dispatch all star teams after his junior year...played for Batting Practice team that won the 2003 NABF World Series...very good student.

#### **Kelly Fisher, OF, 6-0 175, Plum HS, L/R**

A natural ball player...runs like a deer (probably 6.7 in the 60 according to his coach)...great hands...shows good power at the plate...4 HRs this year...covers lots of ground in the outfield...average arm...WR in football...may go the JC route.

**Eric Leuthold, P, 5-9 170, North Allegheny HS, R/R**  
Finished regular season 6-1 with only 8 walks in 38 IP...2.58 ERA...doesn't overpower people (22 Ks) but does a good job of keeping the ball down...curveball is his out pitch.

**Matt Pellis, OF, 6-1 85, Plum HS, R/R**

3 year starter...led team in hitting as a junior with .426 average...line driver hitter with good speed...great in the clutch...a plus arm...great kid to have on your team...WR and QB in football...excellent student...named to the Post-Gazette All Section team after last season.

**Dominick Winters, C/SS/P, 6-1 210, Washington HS, R/R**

Started at SS for 3 seasons but his biggest upside may be as a catcher...not great speed but a very good SS...being recruited for both football and baseball...MLB in football...also team's best pitcher...batted .532 with 7 homers...lots of power...great arm...started as a sophomore for a championship team...doesn't make mistakes...3.1 GPA...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette all section as a junior.

#### DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS

**Justin Ayala, 2B/SS, 5-10 160, Plum HS, R/R**

Top of the order type of a hitter...a slap hitter with excellent speed...good hands and does a good job on the double play...probably a Division III player...also plays soccer.

**Scott Bender, OF/IF, Neshannock HS**

Excellent speed (6.6 in the 60) and a hard worker...hit .580 as a junior with an OBP of .680...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section after his junior season.

**Michael Busin, 3B/SS, 5-8 170, Neshannock HS, R/R**

Hard worker with fair speed (7.2 in the 60)...a starter since his freshman year...surprising power for his size...batted .343 with 6 homers this season...3.2 GPA and 1070 on SATs...has earned many academic awards.

**Butch Carrabbia, 1B, 5-10 185, Sto-Rox HS, R/R**

A good hitter...batting near .500...has pretty good power to all fields...knows the strike zone...makes contact...pretty good defensive first baseman...Division II potential.

**Jeff Foster, 2B/3B, 5-10 160, Knoch HS, R/R**

A hard worker...solid fielder with good hands...has good range...line drive hitter...defense is his strong suit...probably a Division III prospect.

**Joel Galecki, P/1B, 6-4 218, Springdale HS, R/R**

Although he's hitting over .400 seems to be attracting the most attention as a pitcher...has a good fastball and good location and doesn't walk many batters...when I last checked with his coach had 4-2 record with 29 Ks in 28 1/3 innings.

### DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS (cont'd)

**Wes Hughes, 2B/OF, 5-11 165, Connellsville HS, R/R**

Having a great senior season, hitting around .400 with 8 HRs...line drive hitter who can hit the ball out of the park...has a strong arm...has played both 2B and CF this season but future looks to be at 2B...very good speed, runs about 6.8 in the 60.

**Todd Kennedy, C, 6-0 180, Knoch HS, R/R**

A good defensive catcher...blocks the ball well and is a hard worker...has thrown out 4 of 11 base stealers...having a good offensive year...batting over .450 with 2 home runs.

**Donnie Kirkwood, 2B/OF, Neshannock HS, R/R**

Batted .489 this season and scored 23 runs...versatile, can play 2<sup>nd</sup>, short and the outfield...excellent speed (6.6 60)...1030 SATs...also played basketball.

**James Prosser, OF, 5-11 150, Washington HS, L/L**

Extremely quick lead-off hitter...can fly...has a good arm (low 80s MPH)...wiry and shows surprising power...4 HRs this season...good eye...can run the ball down in the outfield...goes all out all the time...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette all section as a junior.

**Mike Reilly, OF/P, 5-11 180, Sto-Rox HS, R/R**

Does a good job of hitting spots...has a good breaking ball...a good outfielder and a consistent player...a contact hitter...probably a Division III prospect.

**Pat Ringle, OF/P, 5-7 160, Sto-Rox HS, R/R**

Excellent speed...a very consistent player who makes contact...hit .500 this year...a good bunter...average arm from the outfield...also a finesse pitcher who hits his spots...shows surprising pitch speed on occasion...probably a Division III prospect.

**Dave Serkoch, 3B, 5-9 160, Sto-Rox HS, R/R**

Line drive hitter with good power...5 HRs so far this season...gap to gap hitter...hitting around .500...very good defensively at 3<sup>rd</sup>...average arm...decent speed but not a blazer...Division II potential...quick hands.

**Zach Toth, P/1B, 6-2 245, Knoch HS, R/R**

Big strong kid...good location on his pitches...throws in the low 80s...also throws curve and change-up...when I talked to his coach had 42 Ks in 42 IP, a 3-2 record and a 0.99 ERA...good student.

**Steve Baranowski, P/1B, 6-0 170, North Hills HS, L/L**

Has not had the kind of year expected but still has the potential to be a top prospect...power pitcher who throws a fastball, curve and change...working on a splitter but it's still in the developmental stage...has a good feel for the change-up and does a good job of using it to set up his fastball...will play AAU baseball for the Pittsburgh Blazers this summer.

#### **Brian Bernardo, IF/P, 6-0 175, Shaler HS, R/R**

Excellent fielder and extremely versatile player...good solid hitter...line drive hitter right now but has the potential to develop into a power hitter...struck out only 3 times this season...great hands...played 3<sup>rd</sup> this season but is probably a college second baseman...good speed...team's leading hitter and probable MVP this season...excellent student.

#### **Gary Buceren, SS/P, 5-10 175, Ambridge HS, R/R**

Great hands and quick feet...great worker....6.9 60...throws 80 MPH...contact hitter with some extra base power....when I talked to his coach had 7 doubles, 5 HRs and .547 average...all around smart player...a starter since his freshman year....3.0 GPA....will attend the Diamond Kings Showcase in Scranton, PA this summer.

#### **Joe Cox, P/1B, 6-2 180, Central Catholic HS, R/L**

Top prospect as a pitcher...excellent control...throws two seam and four seam fastballs, a curve and a change...doesn't overpower people but throws in the 80-85 MPH range...also plays first base and outfield but his future is on the mound...3.3 GPA...Will play for East Pittsburgh Palomino team this summer...also plays basketball.

#### **Josh Hungerman, P/OF, 6-2 160, No Allegheny, L/L**

Had an excellent season as a junior but could be dominating in his senior season...posted 5-0 record, 2.76 ERA and fanned 34 in 25 1/3 innings...still maturing physically and will get bigger and stronger...good overhand curve...mechanically sound hurler who throws 82 MPH...cool customer on the mound...3.3 GPA...will participate in the Beast of the East showcase this summer ... plays summer and fall with the Pittsburgh Blazers.

#### **Mike Juliano, 3B/P, 5-10 175, North Allegheny, R/R**

Good hitter...hits for power...strong kid...mainly a DH this year due to a sore arm, but is a very good infielder...fair speed (7.3 60)...hit over .500 with 4 HRs...14 of his 25 hits were for extra bases...drew 15 walks in 18 games...throws 81 MPH...4.0 GPA....1210 SATs and 23 ACT...will attend the University of Pittsburgh baseball camp this summer...will play this summer and fall for the Pittsburgh Blazers

#### **Jordan Karcher, P/1B, 6-4 210, Shaler HS, R/R**

Power pitcher who throws a fastball, curve and a change...a hard thrower...has excellent power at the plate...good first baseman and has experience behind the plate as well...definite Division IA potential, just a matter of whether its on the mound or as a position player...selected for a Baseball Factory all-star team that competed in a Junior Olympic tournament in AZ last summer...nephew of ex-NFL QB Ken Karcher.

#### **Adam Liberatore, OF/P, 6-1 195, Quigley HS, L/L**

Tons of potential but not quite there yet ...a solid outfielder...great arm strength...great speed (not timed but coach estimates he runs 6.6-6.7)...hits for both power and average...has all the tools...Pittsburgh Post-Gazette all section as a sophomore...good student.

#### **Brian Long, P/3B, 6-1 175, North Hills HS, R/R**

Hard thrower who also has an effective curve and a knuckle ball...good command of his pitches...good fastball...does an excellent job with the knuckler, controlling it well despite using it only occasionally ...needs to get more consistent with his curve.

#### **Kyle Milbert, OF/SS/P, 5-10 160, Quigley HS, R/R**

Hits the ball very well...line driver hitter who hits singles and doubles...mid-season average was .567...excellent bat speed...not a speedster (7.3 in the 60) but gets to the ball well in the outfield and has excellent arm strength ...throws 82 MPH...3.1 GPA...a hard worker...plans to attend the Doyle Baseball Camp in Winter Haven, FL ....will play for Wharmby Sport's Class B team in Youngstown this summer and fall.

#### **Dan Novak, SS/P, 5-11 185, Chartiers-Houston, R/R**

A complete package...led WPIAL in hitting as a soph ...good power as well (7 homers as a junior) and leads WPIAL in RBI (35)...fundamentally very sound on defense...great hands and excellent footwork...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette all section after sophomore season...only sophomore named to Pittsburgh Tribune-Review "Terrific 10" team for 2003 season.

#### **Robert Patula, P/1B, 6-5 230, Mt. Pleasant, R/R**

Have to love his size...a power pitcher who throws in the mid 80s...will increase velocity as he matures...throws a good hard breaking ball...needs to work on controlling his off-speed pitches...4.2 GPA and #6 in his class...will attend Dee Dee Osborne and Blue-Gray (South Carolina) camps and play for Mt. Pleasant Palomino team this summer...named Pittsburgh Post-Gazette all-section after his sophomore season...also a good basketball player.

#### **John Quimby, SS, 5-9 165, North Allegheny HS, R/R**

Very smooth and makes all the plays...excellent range in the field and a good arm...good speed (6.9 60)...hits the ball well...line driver hitter with some pop...batted over .400 with 3 HRs...plans to attend the Wake Forest camp this summer...will play for the Springdale Players this summer...also plays hockey...3.3 GPA and 990 SATs.

#### **Bob Reeping, P/SS, 6-0 185, Derry HS, R/R**

Best college position is likely to be as a middle IF ...batting over .400 with a homer...more of a line driver hitter at this stage...great with the glove...very quick hands and a strong arm...moves his feet well...good speed and a good base runner...also pitches and throws 82 MPH....all conference in football...hard working and willing to learn...will play for the Derry Legion team this summer.

**Derek Wisnieski, 1B/C, 6-4 230, Indiana HS, R/R**  
Intense competitor who can hit with power to all fields and plays solid defense...when I talked to his coach was having an excellent junior season, batting near .500 and with 4 HRs...great candidate for Ivy League schools ... runs 4.7 40...very strong...4.14 GPA....1440 SATs.... major will likely be math or science related...also a prospect as a QB/LB in football...will play for the Indiana Legion team this summer.

**Brian Youchak, SS/2B, 5-7 170, Vincentian Acad., L/R**  
Great middle infielder...excellent hitter at the top of the order...hit .452 as a junior...runs 6.6 in the 60.....very good arm...hardworking and athletic...size is his only negative...excellent student with 4.5 GPA and 1190 SATs ...member of National Honor Society...plans to attend University of Pittsburgh, Virginia Tech and Notre Dame baseball camps and play for the North Hills Palomino team this summer.

**Mike Birsic, P/OF, 6-0 170, North Allegheny HS, R/R**  
Very consistent pitcher with good endurance...more of a power pitcher...throws fastball, curve and a change...will play this summer for the North Allegheny Palomino team...also plays basketball...3.6 GPA.

**Dan Cafaro, OF, 6-0 170, Upper St Clair HS, R/R**  
Has great speed...runs the 60 in the 6.6-6.7 range.... excellent outfielder with outstanding range...decent arm...a contact hitter...excellent base stealer.

**Tony Capozzi, SS/2B, 5-7 160, Mt. Pleasant HS, R/R**  
Good line drive and contact hitter...batting over .400 so far this year with only 1 K....good hands and a strong arm ...hard worker...3.4 GPA and 1050 SATs ...played in Keystone Games in 2003...will play for Mt. Pleasant Palomino team this summer and will attend the Blue-Grey (Wake Forest) and Team One North (Notre Dame) camps.

**Tony Casale, SS/P, 6-0 175, Deer Lakes HS, R/R**  
Line driver hitter who makes consistent contact....hitting around .400 so far this season...strong arm and good range...can make the play from the hole...6.9 in the 60...throws 81 MPH...also plays basketball...3.0 GPA...will play for the West Deer American Legion team this summer and attend the Duke baseball camp.

**Andy Chrobak, IF/P, 6-2 180, Laurel HS, R/R**  
Great hands.... not particularly fast but has a good glove ...a lot of upside...controls the bat well...hits to all fields ...good bunter... 3.9+ GPA....22 on ACTs....also plays basketball...will play for Wharmby's in Youngstown this summer... member of National Honor Society.

**Bryson Fleming, SS/2B, 6-1 170, Monaca HS, R/R**  
Great range and glove....excellent speed... batted .389 as a sophomore....a starter since his freshman season ... excellent lead off man...drew 15 walks as a soph ...4.6 in 40...disciplined player who knows the game... also plays football and basketball....will play for Monaca American Legion team this summer.

**Kevin Garbutt, C/IF/P, 6-1 170, Brownsville HS, R/R**  
Started at 3B as a sophomore but moved to catcher to fill a team need...hits the ball hard and with some power...2 HRs so far this season...is also team's #2 pitcher but potential is as a position player.

**Michael Goedecker, 1B, 5-11 220, Monaca HS, L/R**  
Outstanding hitter with power...knows the game ...3.89 GPA...1040 on SATs....batting .500...batted .381 as a soph and led team in HRs (5) and RBI (24)...also plays football...will play for Monaca American Legion team this summer.

**Tony Greco, P/1B, 6-3 180, New Brighton HS, R/R**  
Fastball clocked at 88 MPH this season...33 Ks so far this season...pitched 6 1/3 innings of no-hit ball in one game this year...clean-up hitter who is batting .387 with OBP of .458 and slugging % of .501...great patience at the plate...3 year letterman in baseball and 2 year letterman in basketball...93% classroom average... will play for New Brighton legion team this summer.

**Blake Jurena, OF, 5-10 170, North Allegheny HS, R/R**  
Lead-off hitter with very good speed (6.8 60)...well-rounded ball player who hustles... line driver hitter with some pop....hit around .350 with 2 HRs...plans to attend Wake Forest baseball camp and play for Batting Practice this summer...3.5 GPA.

**Dave Koerbel, P, 6-2 180, Central Catholic HS, R/R**  
Finesse pitcher...throws fastball, curve, slider and change ...outstanding control of all his pitches...last two starts were complete games with no walks...so far this season has about a 2.6 ERA and a 3-1 record.

**Mike Lingenfield, 3B/OF/C, 5-9 165, Mt. Pleasant, R/R**  
Good power and a quick bat...can hit the gaps...runs 6.7 60...versatile player...above average defensively but will improve once he settles into a position...a leader ...4.0 GPA and 1070 SATs...will attend the Dee Dee Osborne, Blue Gray Classic (VA) and Diamond King camps and play for Mt. Pleasant Palomino team this summer.

**Greg Marshall, 3B/P, 6-0 185, West Allegheny HS, R/R**  
Lots of potential...great athlete...plays QB in football ...powerful hitter...batting .476 so far this season with 5 homers and 25 RBI in 19 games...as a pitcher has 61 Ks in 56 innings and a 1.63 ERA.

**Andy McIlvane, P/1B, 6-0 175, Chartiers-Houston, R/L**  
Very smart pitcher who throws 4 pitches well....very effective against left handed batters....crafty pitcher who throws from different arm slots...excellent at first base ...batted .500 with 5 homers...very heady player...starter since his freshman year.
