American Legion All-Star Game

The All-West Legion All-Star game will be held at PNC Park in Pittsburgh on July 8th. Players are to report at 8 a.m. I have not been able to find out what time the game starts.

MLB Draft

Five western Pennsylvania players were selected in the first five rounds of the Major League Baseball draft. The Pirates selected Pine-Richland's Neil Walker, a catcher, with the 11th pick in the draft. The Blue Jays selected Seneca Valley's Zach Jackson, a pitcher, from Texas A&M with a first round supplemental choice. The Red Sox selected North Allegheny's Andrew Dobies, a pitcher, from the University of Virginia in the third round. Mike Butia, another North Allegheny product, from James Madison, an outfielder, was selected by the Indians in the fifth round. Also in the fifth round, the Dodgers chose Anthony Raglani, an outfielder, from Indiana HS and George Washington U.

Other local selections included IF Grant Psomas (Keystone Oaks HS and West Virginia U) by the Mets in the 15th round, Clayton Hamilton (Blackhawk HS and Penn State) by the Padres in the 17th round, OF Stan Posluzny (Hopewell HS and West Virginia U) by the Angels in the 21st round, IF Dale Mollenhauer (Pine-Richland HS and committed to East Carolina) by the Orioles in the 24th round, IF Jared Shaffer (Kiski Area HS and committed to Liberty) by the Braves in the 40th round, IF Dan Schwartzbauer (Shaler HS and Duquesne U) by the Pirates in the 41st round and IF Andy Goff (Mt. Lebanon HS and committed to Wake Forest) by the Rockies in the 50th round,

Player Thumbnails

This section includes thumbnail descriptions of players who have been recommended to WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS since the May issue was published. Questionnaires have also been received from several players whose coaches did not provide a recommendation as to their potential. Thumbnails on these players are included in a section called "Unrated."

As we have in prior issues, players are listed by graduating class and then alphabetically within four categories. The first category includes only those players who are considered to have the potential to play for major Division I teams. The second category includes those players who are considered to have the potential to play for lower Division I teams. The third category includes those players who have Division II or Division III potential. . The final category, as mentioned in the preceding paragraph includes those players who did not receive a ranking from their coach.

The placement of players within these categories is based principally on information provided by local high school coaches. WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS does not scout these players and does not render an independent opinion.

DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS

Mike DePace, C/P, 6-2 160, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Did not have a good year at the plate this season but has always been an effective hitter...good power to the gaps...very athletic behind the plate and has lots of upside...shows a good arm ...also pitches and is a hard thrower...has Division II potential.

HIGH DIVISION I PROSPECTS

Rich Adkins, C/IF, 5-9 165, Canon McMillan HS, R/R
Best college position is catcher but he likely start at SS next season...starter since sophomore season...line drive hitter who batted .369 this season...student of the game ...arm is average but has a very quick release and has about a 1.9 pop...very good hands...excellent athlete ...will attend Team One camp at Notre Dame..

Sam DiMatteo, C/P, 6-0 180, Center HS, R/R
A starter since his sophomore season...good power...hit 6 HRs as a sophomore and 4 as a junior...batted .500 as a junior and added 8 doubles...good defensive catcher ...strong arm...throws 85 MPH...excellent foot speed for a catcher, running a 6.6 60...also plays football ...good student with a 3.5-3.7 GPA...will play Legion ball and attend the Bat's Factory camp in Erie, PA this summer.

Brandon Dittmar, 1B/P, 6-1 175, Canon McMillan, L/R
Very versatile and can play almost anywhere...starter since sophomore season...line driver hitter with some pop...batted .383 as a junior and hit 2 HRs and drove in 28 runs (in 19 games)...a good base runner he also led his team in steals with 10...a leader and an excellent athlete.

Matt Hanley, OF/P, 6-1 185, Franklin Regional, R/R
Was more of a doubles and gap hitter this season but has the potential to be a power hitter...excellent arm strength ...great explosion to the ball...6.8 in the 60...a great kid who keeps improving...has given up other sports to concentrate on baseball.

Tom McAllister, OF, 6-1 195, Connellsville HS, R/L
Tremendous speed...runs a 6.6 60...very good arm strength and is good defensively...a line driver hitter who hit close to .500 this season...good hitter when ahead in the count.

Casey Shultz, P, 6-4 215, Connellsville HS, R/R
Hard thrower (85-88 MPH) and has a good curve and changeup...needs to become more consistent...good movement on his fastball...mainly used as a reliever as a junior.

Zach Skowvron, OF/C, 6-1 185, Southside Beaver, R/R
A very motivated player...a hard worker...hits for both power and average...batted .525 as a junior and .459 as a sophomore...975 slugging average as a junior, including 3 HRs...fair speed (7.17 in 60)...solid all around player ...excellent student with 4.0 GPA and 1310 SATs...will play for Hopewell Legion team this summer.

Jeff Vincent, SS/2B, 5-11 180, Franklin Regional, R/R
Great work ethic and determined to be the best...lowered speed from 7.2 to 6.8 after an ACL injury...lead off hitter who batted .381 and stole 19 bases as a junior...probably better suited to be a #2 hitter...line driver hitter with some pop...great hands and a steady glove...strong arm ...excellent student with 3.94 GPA and 1120 on SATS ...will play for Murrysville Legion team this summer ...the last 5 shortstops at Franklin Regional have gone on to play Division I baseball.

LOWER DIVISION I PROSPECTS

Alex Herrnberger, C/P, 6-0 170, Canon McMillan, S/R
Hit in the lead-off spot and batted .342...line drive hitter who is very patient at the plate...good defensive catcher who has improved greatly over the last couple of years ...good arm and quick release...1.9 pop...also pitches and had 3.71 ERA in 23 IP...a control pitcher with an excellent curve.

Mike McCarthy, SS/2B, 5-6, Baldwin HS, R/R
Very quick player (6.75 in the 60)...quick hands...patient hitter who will hit doubles and triples...has a good arm and throws 83 MPH...also does some pitching...will play this summer for the Pittsburgh Tigers and will attend showcases at Team One (Notre Dame), the Blue Grey Classic (Wake Forest) and the Ed Santa Select Invitational (West Virginia)...good student with 3.2 GPA.

Matt McCartney, P/IF, 6-2 190, Baldwin HS, R/R
Throws about 83 MPH...out pitch is his change-up...throws a good slider...does a good job of hitting spots...brother plays college ball...very smart pitcher, taking advantage of what the batter gives him...good baseball sense and strong fundamentals...good student with a 3.7 GPA and 960 SATs...a hard worker...runs a 7.2 60...will play for the Baldwin American Legion team this summer...also plays basketball.

Alex Paluka, OF/C, 6-0 170, Franklin Regional, L/L
First year playing in WPIAL after moving from Wisconsin ... line drive hitter who hits to the gaps...above average arm strength...reads the ball well and gets a good jump ...7.0 in the 60...hard worker.

Gary Pierpont, P/IF, 6-1 170, Canon McMillan, L/R
Also started at 2B but best potential seems to be on the mound...had 4-0 record with 36 Ks in 31 IP...a sneaky fast pitcher who throws 83-84 MPH...hits spots well ...also throws a good curve and a straight change...still growing...long arms and long legs and looks like he's all arms when he delivers the ball.

Jason Shepard, P/3B, 6-0 190, Franklin Regional, R/R
Had an excellent junior year with a 5-0 record and a 1.65 ERA in a very competitive conference...still learning how to pitch...best pitch is his 84-85 MPH fastball...also throws a curve and a change-up...has a good, loose arm and bounces back quickly.

Brian Thompson, C/P/1B, 6-4 195, Baldwin HS, R/R
Has only started catching recently and has excellent upside...still very raw behind the plate but does a good job of blocking the ball and has an excellent arm (85 MPH)...a good bat and can hit for power...excellent student with a 4.14 GPA and 1110 SATs...has grown 4 or 5 inches in the last year.

Phil Avolio, P/1B, 5-9 160, Canon McMillan HS, L/L
Average fastball but a good change-up...the baseball equivalent of a gym rat...still has a way to go but does have the potential to be a college player...only pitched 9 varsity innings this year.

Nick Basso, OF, 5-10 175, Canon McMillan HS, R/R
Line driver hitter who batted .286 as a junior but had an OBP of .474...good defensively and has a good arm...a real perfectionist...1500 on SATs...wants to go Ivy League...solid Division II prospect.

Alex Bohince, 3B/1B, 5-10 185, Greensburg-Salem HS, R/R

Good bat speed and attacks the ball...line driver hitter who shows some power...played 1B this season but 3B is probably his best college position...also catches ... Division III prospect.

Shane Cisko, IF, 5-3 NA, Baldwin HS, R/R

A strong middle infielder with good speed (7.0 in 60) ...has very good range and an above average arm...a singles hitter who is very patient and draws walks...all heart and gives 110%...MVP and leading scorer in soccer ...will play this summer for the Baldwin Legion team ...2.9-3.0 GPA.

John Fagert, OF/P, 5-10 155, Greensburg-Salem, L/L

Has a great attitude...an excellent control pitcher throws a good breaking ball and a good change ...needs to get stronger and increase his velocity...also an above average hitter...Division III prospect.

Joe Fogel, OF, 5-9 160, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Excellent range (6.9 in the 60)...gets good jump on the ball ...excellent arm strength...contact hitter...3.98 GPA and #10 in his class...three year letterman...team captain in 2004...member of National Honor Society...has stolen 27 bases in 32 attempts in 3 years.

Jacob Houser, OF/3B, 5-11 165, West Shamokin, R/R

Lead-off hitter who led team in hitting with .395 average...had 5 extra base hits and 4 were homers...has also caught in an emergency and is expected to pitch next season... will play for Armstrong Central legion team this summer.

Chris Kozak, OF/2B, 5-5 170, Baldwin HS, R/R

Line driver hitter who finds the gaps...good speed and very quick hands...arm is above average and is very accurate...strong defensively...very strong fundamentally ...leads by example...good student with 3.8 GPA.

Eric Lang, OF, 5-9 160, Canon McMillan HS, R/R

Very quick hands and a good fastball hitter...batted .306...good speed and an average arm in the outfield ...also plays hockey and has had to deal with overlapping seasons...potential to get better if he devotes more time to baseball.

DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS (cont'd)

Scott Macarelli, OF, 5-9 175, Canon McMillan, R/R

Excellent athletic ability...excellent potential but must work on his mental approach to the game...left team and didn't play as a junior...very good speed...good outfielder who must work on this throwing.

Anthony Manley, 3B/C, 5-9 175, Greensburg-Salem HS, R/R

Team's leading hitter with .455 average...line drive hitter...excellent defensive third baseman who is very smooth and has a good arm...is playing shortstop this summer for his Legion team...very determined player with above average speed...also plays basketball and football and may be captain of all three teams next season...solid Division II prospect.

Corey Peck, 3B/1B, 6-2 200, Canon McMillan, R/R

Great athletic specimen...has lots of upside and can be a power hitter...good speed and has excellent hands...also plays football...one to keep an eye on during his senior year.

Sean Russell, 3B/1B, 6-0 175, Canon McMillan, R/R

Hit .333 in limited action...ended up splitting duty at 3rd but will be counted on to contribute more as a senior ...line driver hitter...average defensively...also a football player.

Nate Semovoski, P/OE, 5-9 150, Center HS, R/L

Finesse pitcher who keeps you guessing...throws a good knuckleball and curve ball...reaches about 79 MPH on his fastball...also a good contact hitter...had a 5-2 record as a junior...plans to attend the Duquesne baseball camp this summer...3.0 GPA.

Tyler Steffy, 3B/P, 5-10 145, West Shamokin HS, R/R

Throws a fastball and a curve and has steadily improved every year...very hard worker...batted .305 as a junior but average was as high as .396 before tailing off late in the season...good kid who does mission work in Latin America in the summer.

R T Tourek, P/1B, 6-3 215, Shadyside Academy, L/L

Came on strong at the end of the season...3.5 GPA and 1260 SATs...great control and an above average fastball ...Also a power hitter who can drive the ball to the opposite field...fanned 17 in 15 2/3 innings with only 4 walks and a 2.23 ERA...batted .379 in 29 ABs and hit two homers...one to watch in his senior season.

John Zerbini, P/SS/2B, 5-11 165, Greensburg-Salem HS, R/R

An effective pitcher who is also an excellent fielding infielder...excellent attitude...throws hard and has a nice breaking ball...more of a power pitcher...a Division III prospect.

Came on strong as a junior...developed consistency with his curveball this season...throws in the lows 80s...is also working on a forkball...39 Ks and 14 BBs in 40 2/3 IP258 ERA...opponents batted .203 against him...3.5 GPA and 1070 SATs...has a can do attitude and is a real team player...will play for Riverside Legion team this summer.

Danny Brown, P/2B, 5-11 165, Riverside HS, R/R

Only pitched 29 innings this season due to minor arm irritations but was very effective...throws in the mid the mid-80s...throws a curve and sometimes drops down to a submarine motion...31Ks and only 2 BBs this season1.21 ERA and a .168 average against...also played 2B and is a good line drive hitter, batting .431 this season... 2.7 GPA and 1130 SATs....will play for Riverside Legion team this summer.

Evan Browne, 2B/SS/OE, 6-0 172, Thomas Jefferson HS, R/R

Good contact hitter who batted around .500 this season...runs a 6.9 60...hard worker...all section in soccer and football...good student with a 3.85 GPA

Dan Vietmeier, 3B/2B/P, 6-0 165, Montour HS, R/R

A ground ball/line drive hitter who batted .350 this season...team MVP...only struck out twice...excellent defensive infielder with a strong arm...runs a 6.8 60... throws 86 MPH...best pitch is his curveball...also throws an improving change-up...had a 6-2 record this high school season...always hustles...good student with a 3.5 GPA.

Sean Douglas, 3B, 6-0 180, Canon McMillan HS, R/R

A pleasant surprise during his sophomore season...batted .302 with a home run...a middle of the lineup type hitter ...hits line drives but has good power potential ...swings bat very well and has excellent bat speed ...strong arm ... defensive will improve with experience ...might also see action on the mound in future.

Greg Frederick, SS/P, 6-1 155, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Very strong arm...excellent speed...stole 13 bases in 14 attempts this season...has good gap power...patient at the plate...drew 12 walks in his sophomore season while batting .271...2 year letterman...good fielder...stuck out 33 in 39 innings...needs to work on his control...3.1 GPA

Matt McTiernan, 1B/OE, 6-2 195, Quaker Valley, L/L

Excellent hitter for both average and power...2 year starter...does a good job of getting on base...good first baseman and excellent outfielder...gets good jump on the ball...team player and a quick learner with a great attitude...3.75 GPA.

Dave Powers, 2B/SS, 5-8 150, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Slick middle infielder with very good speed...makes good contact at the plate but also shows some pop in his bat...2 year starter...quick bat with good power to the gaps ... does a good job of getting on base...2 game winning RBIs in 2004 season...7.0 speed in the 60...lettered in varsity basketball as a sophomore.

Ryan Thomas, P/SS, 6-3 160, Center HS, R/R

A basketball player who came out for baseball for the first time as a sophomore...was 4-0 with 2 saves as a sophomore...great arm...throws his fastball in the mid 80s...average curve but is working on improving...tall lanky pitcher who needs to add weight...probably will start at SS next season as well...one to keep an eye on.

Josh Fortuna, OF, 5-8 160, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Extreme passion for the game...good speed and an accurate arm...contact hitter who gets on base...Division III prospect.

Pat Oakes, 3B/2B, 5-8 145, Baldwin HS, R/R

Hard worker who played junior varsity this season ... fundamentally sound...average arm...good range in the in infield...a gap hitter.

Joe Scherer, C/P, 5-10 170, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Very versatile player who can play almost any position ...fundamentally strong as both a pitcher and a catcher ...good defensive catcher...good contact hitter with gap power....Division III prospect....getting stronger.

HIGH DIVISION I PROSPECTS

Len Gallo, SS/2B, 5-10 165, Franklin Regional, R/R

Saw no varsity time due to injury but is a probable starter at 2B next year...will get bigger and stronger...comes from a family of good athletes...runs 7.2 60....good arm and bat...a very hard worker who will end up as one of the better players produced by Franklin Regional.

DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS

Evan Fields, 2B/OE, 5-8 150, Quaker Valley HS, R/R

Very versatile kid who can play almost every position...good contact guy with power to the gaps...does a good job of going with the pitch...stays back well on the curve ball...average arm that should improve as he matures...should grow as his father is 6-2/6-3...good speed but needs to improve his first step.

Matt Katich, P/C, 6-2 170, Mohawk HS, R/R

Became a DH starter with occasional OF duty about 1/3 of the way into the season...ended up team's second leading hitter with .467 average and .580 OBP...excellent potential...2.0 pop...throws in the low 80s and was an effective pitcher in the 14 year old Babe Ruth World Series for the 2003 championship Youngstown (OH) team...a perfectionist...runs a 7.3 60...excellent student with 4.0 GPA...will play for Rondinelli Tuxedo in the Youngstown Babe Ruth league this summer.

Prospect List

Following is an updated list of the prospects that have been recommended to WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS by area high school coaches. Recommendations continue to be received and this listing will continue to be updated in future issues. The list only includes players from high schools that have responded to our information requests.

The list does not include players who I know have already made final college decisions. The prospect list is organized by the player's graduation year. Within each graduation class, players are listed in four categories: 1) players who are NCAA "High" Division I prospects; 2) players who are NCAA "Lower" Division IA prospects; 3) players who are NCAA Division II or Division III prospects and 4) players whose coaches did not provide a rating. I did not include NAIA in any of the groups only because I leave it to the NAIA coaches to decide their level of NCAA baseball equivalency.

Players that have been added to the prospect list since the May issue are highlighted in **bold print**. In addition, any players who have had any information (such as height or weight) updated will have the updated information shown in **bold**. Any players whose rating has changed will have a "+" (where the rating has been raised) or a "-" (where the rating has been lowered).
