Players are listed by graduating class and then alphabetically within four categories:

1. Players who considered to have the potential to play for major Division I teams.
2. Players who are considered to have the potential to play for lower Division I teams.
3. Players who have the potential to play Division II or Division II college base ball.
4. Players who did not receive a ranking from their high school coach.

The placement of players within these categories is based principally on information provided by local high school coaches. WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS does not scout these players and does not render an independent opinion.

### 2005 GRADUATES

#### HIGH DIVISION I PROSPECTS

##### **Brad Bothell, C/SS, 5-11 195, Kittanning HS, B/R**

Topped off a great junior season by being named to the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section team and then was selected to participate in the Palomino All-Star game and played in American Legion East-West All-Star game in Harrisburg...runs 60 in 6.7-6.8...pop time of 1.8-1.9...in his high school season batted .500 with 7 HRs and 26 stolen bases...offered a tryout by the Atlanta Braves...has all the tools...also wrestles and plays HB in football.

##### **Matt Litzinger, OF/P, 6-3 180, Serra Catholic HS, L/R**

As a junior batted .508 with 2 HRs and 32 RBI...as a pitcher was 6-0 with 37 Ks in 33 innings and a 1.94 ERA...extremely hard worker and a very athletic player...throws a fastball, curve, knuckleball and slider...a finesse pitcher, with fastball measuring in high 70s to low 80s...student of the game...4.0 GPA with 1010 SATs...McKeesport Daily News player of the year.

#### LOWER DIVISION I PROSPECTS

##### **Jeremy Deluca, OF, 5-11 170, Kittanning HS, R/R**

Good speed (6.9-7.0 60) and is an excellent bunter...a line driver hitter who batted .347 with 1 HR and 14 stolen bases...excellent range in the field and gets a good jump on the ball...arm strength between average and above average and is improving...plays QB in football.

##### **Derek Fallecker, SS, 5-11 175, Kiski Area, R/R**

Great arm strength from the shortstop position...throws 85-88 MPH...great attitude and a hard-nosed kid...runs 60 in 7.0...great contact hitter with excellent bat speed...gained 20 pounds last offseason and has been aggressive at the plate and has shown some power...working on going with the pitch...good and aggressive base runner...excellent in the clutch.

##### **Josh Guthrie, P/2B, 6-0 145, Kittanning HS, R/R**

Good fastball (84-87 MPH) and registered 57Ks...good curveball and change is improving...also a good infielder and batted .375 with 1 HR and 12 stolen bases...singles and doubles hitter...runs 7.2 60...will hit the weights this winter and hopes to be 10-15 pounds heavier next spring.

#### DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS

##### **Michael Battocchi, OF/C, 5-10 170, Pgh Central Catholic HS, R/R**

Moving up to varsity for senior season...disciplined line driver hitter...decent fielder with a good arm...runs 60 in 7.3...pop time is 2.2...batted .370 on JV with .420 OBP and had 23 RBIs...2.5 GPA and 980 SATs...Division III possibility.

##### **Zach Gacek, 2B, 5-6 145, Albert Gallatin HS, L/R**

Line driver hitter who is more quick than fast (7.15 60)...line driver hitter who is a top of the order kind of batter...scrappy kid who is a good defensive player...good enough athlete to also play SS...batted .379 in 29 at bats on a senior-dominated team...probably a Division III prospect.

##### **Michael Ginand, 3B/P/OF, 5-10 170, Beaver Falls, L/R**

Made Post-Gazette All-Section as a pitcher...throws 85 MPH...great arm strength and an excellent eye at the plate...very versatile and can play anywhere but catcher...starter since his freshman season...batted .468 as a junior with an OBP of .679...showed some pop with 2 HRs...was 4-2 as a pitcher with 25Ks in 40 IPs but his potential is probably greatest as a position player...probably a Division III prospect.

##### **Matt Gouveia, OF/2B, 5-11 160, Elizabeth-Forward HS, B/R**

Good speed and arm...plays center field and can also play the infield...was a team captain as a junior...batted .245 during the high school season but showed much better hitting ability this summer, batting .472 with an OBP of .681...3.3 GPA...Division III prospect.

##### **Zach Jones, OF, 5-7 150, South Park HS, R/R**

Speedy outfielder...Post Gazette All-Section selection as both a sophomore and a junior...solid hitter...average arm...probable Division III prospect.

##### **Scott Plaski, P/3B, 5-11 175, Albert Gallatin HS, R/R**

Batted .269 in limited action (26 ABs)...performance was restricted by a hamstring injury...can hit for power but hamstring injury curtailed that aspect of his game during his junior year...also a finesse pitcher who posted a 2-1 record in 22 innings...throws in high 70s but has an effective curve and change and does a good job of hitting his spots...above average arm at 3<sup>rd</sup> and runs a 7.4 60...probable Division III prospect.

##### **Justin Rodabaugh, P/3B, 6-2 195, Elizabeth-Forward, R/R**

Probably a Division III prospect but has some upside...throws in the mid-80s and shows good command of two pitches...registered 47 Ks in 49 IP with only 12 walks...finished with a 4-3 record and a 3.52 ERA...also batted .283 with an OBP of .475...3.0 GPA.

##### **Matt Starmack, C/1B, 5-10 210, Elizabeth-Forward HS, R/R**

A line driver hitter with good baseball instincts...a leader who was a team captain as a junior...batted .396 as a junior with a .508 OBP...calls a good game behind the plate...very good student with 3.65 GPA and 1010 SATs...not great speed (7.65 60) but is a smart base runner...2.1 pop time...could play Division II.

##### **Eric Valencic, 2B/OF, 5-10 170, Canon McMillan, R/R**

Singles/doubles hitter and an excellent defender...good field vision and good instincts...runs 4.95 40...3.0 GPA and 970 SATs...batted .312 for JV as a junior...a Division III possibility.

##### **Derek Victor, C/1B/P, 5-10 185, Albert Gallatin, R/R**

A solid player who can help you at several positions...an outstanding defensive 1B but will probably catch...above average arm and is fundamentally sound...batted .240 as a junior in 25 ABs...also pitches and was 1-0 with a save...probable Division III prospect.

##### **Adam Yingling, OF, 5-10 160, Kiski Area HS, R/R**

Covers a lot of ground in the outfield...very quick player...runs 60 in 7.0...good leader...excellent bat speed and a good contact hitter...good natural athlete who excels at basketball, golf and baseball...added strength and weight would help him develop...aggressive base runner.

### UNRATED PROSPECTS

##### **Anthony Cirocco, OF/P, 6-2 160, Penn-Trafford, R/L**

Solid outfielder...worked as a closer for his Legion team this summer...throws around 76 MPH but has excellent off-speed stuff...7.1 60 speed...3.0 GPA with 930 SATs...batted .258 for high school season but improved to .320 during Legion season...pitched 20 innings for Legion with 0.70 ERA and 3 saves...16Ks and 13 walks.

##### **Scott Dunn, P/SS/3B, 5-10 184, Southside Beaver, B/R**

Hard thrower who typically reaches the high 80s on the mound...5-2 during Legion season with 1.96 ERA with 45Ks and 26 walks in 46 innings...also a solid position player and batted .345 with 2 HRs in Legion season...team leader who is very versatile...performed very well at recent Blue-Grey Showcase (William & Mary) running a sub-7.0 60 and reaching 90 MPH...Blue-Grey staffer told him he had D-1 potential as both a pitcher and a 3B...82% GPA.

##### **Michael Harvart, C/IF/OF, 5-8 165, Hempfield, R/R**

Did not have a great high school season on offense (.238 BA) but batted .362 in Legion ball and was 5 for 10 for the Pennsylvania team in the Blue Grey Classic in Tampa, FL...2.1 pop time...excellent student with 3.97 GPA and 1160 SAT...high character individual with his own website ([www.mikeharvat.com](http://www.mikeharvat.com)).

##### **Ron Kramer, OF/2B, 5-10 155, Woodland Hills, R/R**

Good defensive player and a contact hitter...versatile player who plays all three outfield positions...batted .396 as a junior with an OBP of .453...batted .351 this summer playing for the Monroeville Legion team...good student with 3.78 GPA.

##### **Mark McRobie, OF/P, 6-2 180, Penn-Trafford HS, L/L**

Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section selection...good speed (7.0 60) and arm (80 MPH)...batted .364 as a junior...also pitched and had a 2-1 record, 3.91 ERA and 18 Ks in 20 innings...3.71 GPA and 1130 SATs.

##### **Rob Timo, P, 6-0 170, Greensburg Central Catholic HS, R/R**

Pittsburgh Post-Gazette All-Section selection...hard worker...good leadership qualities...throws 85 MPH...has fastball, curve and change...curveball is his out pitch...7-0 as a junior with 0.82 ERA...30 Ks and 16 walks in 43 IP...6-1 this summer with 36 Ks and 19 walks in 47 IP...3.1 GPA and 980 SATs.

#### HIGH DIVISION I PROSPECTS

##### **Jason Conley, P, 6-3 210, Peters Township HS, R/R**

Has the potential to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the WPIAL for the next two seasons...throws in the mid to upper 80s...also has excellent breaking stuff...was 6-2 and played critical role in his team reaching the state title game...notched playoff wins against tough Pine-Richland, Seneca Valley and Kiski teams.

**Matt Davis, P/1B, 6-3 215 Shaler HS, R/L**

Transferring from Fox Chapel to Shaler...power pitcher with a good change-up and a decent curve ball...very good athletic ability...also plays basketball and is a QB in football...excellent defensive first baseman who can hit the ball...one to watch in the 2005 season.

**Connor Dixon, SS/3B, 6-5 170, South Park HS, R/R**

Batted cleanup as a sophomore and hit over .400...more of a doubles hitter...runs very well and could be a top of the lineup hitter...good base runner...very good arm...a QB in football...played 3<sup>rd</sup> base last season but will move to SS for the 2005 season.

**Colin Durborow, SS/2B, 5-11 170, Pine-Richland, R/R**

Played in the shadows of Neil Walker and Dale Mollenhauer (both MLB draftees)...played outfield last season but will move to middle infield for his junior year...runs 60 in 6.9...aggressive hitter who attacks the ball.

**J. J. Hoover, P, 6-2 215, Elizabeth-Forward HS, R/R**

A power pitcher who has thrown 89 MPH...fanned 80 batters in only 47 1/3 innings to lead the WPIAL as a sophomore...had a 4-2 record with a 2.80 ERA...made the Palomino all-star team...big-time potential and will only get better with experience...3.2 GPA and 940 SATs...wants to teach.

**Nolan Meister, OF/P, 6-2 210, Shaler HS, R/R**

Played first half of season on the JV and batted over .500...moved to varsity in midseason and started the rest of the way...very strong arm...pitched this summer for the first time in several years...strong and has plenty of power...good speed for his size...also a MLB and TE in football and is a D-1 prospect...brother is a 295 lb. lineman for Miami of Ohio.

**Tyler Scruggs, C, 6-1 230, South Park HS, R/R**

Post Gazette All-Section selection as both a freshman and a sophomore...has all the tools...a likely high draft choice in 2006...tremendous power and runs very well for his size (sub 7.0 in the 60)...good arm...batted .549 with 4 HRs...excellent defensive catcher...threw out 18 of 20 attempted base stealers...grandson of former major league pitcher Jim Rooker...top-flight RB in football.

**Morgan Singletary, C, 5-9 210, Montour HS, R/R**

Shoulder problems this summer restricted him to first base duty...can throw with both hands...even pitched this summer as a lefty...very good hitter with excellent power...plays football...Post Gazette All-Section selection.

#### LOWER DIVISION I PROSPECTS

**Shane Eckles, SS/P/OE, 6-1 185, Peters Township, R/R**

Outstanding athletic ability...excellent fundamentals...started in RF but will move to the middle infield next season...runs 40 in 4.6 and 60 in 6.78...plays QB and S in football...excellent student with 4.2 GPA.

**Adam Gill, P/1B, 6-3 210, South Park HS, L/R**

An intriguing prospect who may be underrated...power pitcher who should reach the mid 80s...also throws a slider and a change and is working on both two seam and four seam fastballs...will throw harder as he gets stronger and more mature physically...didn't bat much last season but has good power...will probably be a #5 hitter next season...also plays TE in football.

**Kevin McGuire, C/P, 6-2 200, Peters Township, R/R**

Not a well-known name, but one who can come on in the next two seasons...solid, strong catcher...above average arm behind the plate with a quick release...hits with good power to all fields...throws in the low 80s with quality stuff...also can play outfield.

**Cory Ulm, P, 5-11 150, South Allegheny HS, L/L**

Throws in the low 80s with good movement...aggressive pitcher who isn't easily rattled on the mound...worked mostly in relief as a soph (21 innings) but will be his team's #1 starter next season...needs to continue to work on off speed stuff...excellent student.

#### DIVISION II/III PROSPECTS

**Mike Lugarich, SS/2B, 5-10 180, Elizabeth-Forward HS, R/R**

Line drive hitter with good speed (4.6 40)...sound fundamentals...solid defensive player with a good arm...batted .361 with an OBP of .400 and showed some power with 3 HRs...very competitive player...excellent student with a 4.0 GPA...wants to go into forensic science or physical therapy...Division II prospect.

#### UNRATED PROSPECTS

**Jon Anthony, P/1B, 6-4 190, Hempfield HS, R/R**

Big kid who throws pretty hard (82 MPH)...runs 60 in 7.6...moving up to varsity after two years of JV...very good student with 97% average and is in top 5-10% of his class.

**Harry Austin, OF/2B, 5-7 145, North Allegheny, R/R**

Played mainly JV as a sophomore but did get a few varsity at bats...very quick (6.8 60) and gets to the ball in the OF very well...hits the ball well despite his size...tendency to discount him because of his size but has lots of potential.

**Pat Dougherty, P/OE, 5-8 185, Shaler HS, L/L**

Missed his sophomore high school season with a knee injury...throws in the low 80s and does a good job with his off speed stuff...throws a curve and a splitter...does a good job of hitting spots...had a very good summer on the mound...also a good hitter with power...played for Keystone Games team in 2003.

**John Hess, P/OE, 5-9 165, Pittsburgh Central Catholic HS, R/R**

Throws in the mid 80s with good movement...maturing into a pitcher...plays solid outfield with good speed...excellent hitter with surprising power...only sophomore to start for Central's varsity last season.

**John Karr, P/OF, 6-0 185, Pine-Richland HS, R/R**

Came up big in the WPIAL playoffs last season with a complete game performance in their championship game victory...throws in the mid 80s...also an excellent outfielder with very good speed...a streaky hitter.

**Geoff Lang, P/OF, 5-10 160, North Allegheny HS, L/L**

Played JV as a sophomore but has excellent college potential...should move into the varsity rotation this season...throws a nasty curve and a sneaky fastball (81 MPH)...had ERA of 0.71 for the JV and 0.98 for his summer league team...threw a no-hitter this summer...runs 60 in 6.9.

**Nick Mains, 3B/C, 5-9 170, Southmoreland HS, R/R**

Letter winner as freshman and a sophomore and started as a soph....good throwing arm and a contact hitter...5.0 40 speed...batted .349 as a soph with an OBP of .480.. excellent student with a 4.0 GPA and is ranked first in his class...looking for a career in the medical field.

**Christopher Marsili, P/OF/IF, 6-0 170, St. Josephs, R/R**

Pitched for his high school team as a sophomore and showed potential...needs to gain better command of his pitches...versatile player with good arm...coming along as a hitter.

**David Monteleone, OF/P, 6-5 205, Seneca Valley, R/R**

Big, athletic kid with a lot of raw talent...one to keep an eye on...could develop into a top player...played CF for JV team as a soph...covers a lot of ground in the OF and has a good arm...more of a gap hitter...also plays basketball and soccer...a good basketball player who blocks shots and jumps well... runs 60 in 7.3...does some pitching and throws a fastball (untimed but probably in the low 80s) and a curve...working on a splitter.

**Michael Morgan, 3B/1B/OF, 5-10 195, Pine-Richland HS, R/R**

MVP in this year's Freeport International Tournament...powerfully built yet very athletic...3 sport varsity letterman (baseball, football, wrestling)...very versatile, can play almost anywhere...excellent student with 3.5 GPA...excellent in the clutch and a smart player...still improving...batted .365 in Palomino ball with .460 OBP.

**Adam Rayburg, P/IF, 6-0 205, Valley HS, R/R**

Very competitive attitude...knows how to pitch and has command of his pitches...a corner infielder...good power to all fields and can be a run producer.

**Kevan Smith, C, 6-3 210, Seneca Valley HS, R/R**

Could be a big-time prospect...junior season will be his third on the varsity...has great tools and kills the ball...played DH as a sophomore (a senior caught) and batted cleanup...7.0 in the 60...caught and played 3<sup>rd</sup> this summer.

### 2007 GRADUATES

#### HIGH DIVISION I PROSPECTS

**Nick Czapor, SS/3B/P, 6-0 190, South Allegheny, R/R**

College position is probably at 3B...strong kid who is very athletic (7.0 60)...batted .300 as a freshman while starting every game at three different positions...mainly a line driver hitter...bat speed a little slow but that is expected to improve as he matures physically and learns the game...major upside potential.

**Gene Franks, 1B/3B/OF, 6-1 190, Albert Gallatin, R/R**

Had an excellent freshman season....started at DH but will be a corner infielder or corner outfielder...runs 7.4 60...has a good baseball head and works extremely hard...batted .458 with 6 homers and 25 RBI...OBP of .492 and slugging average of .847...excellent power...finished the season on a 16 game hitting streak...sound defensive player who has very good footwork at 1B...1st team all-section as a DH and named to the All-Fayette County team...a likely big-time prospect who should receive plenty of attention.

#### LOWER DIVISION I PROSPECTS

**Jon Craine, C, 5-9 165, South Allegheny HS, L/R**

A natural catcher with a great knowledge of the game...good arm and decent catching skills...improved defensively as his freshman season went on...good contact hitter who batted .306 as a lead-off hitter...excellent leadership skills...needs to work on his foot speed.

**Brandon Myers, OF/P, 5-10 155, South Allegheny, R/R**

Started every game in center field as a frosh...excellent athletic ability with good speed (6.9 60)...hit .303 and led team in stolen bases...developed some pop in his bat by the end of the season and became a run producer...great work ethic and an excellent student...this season was his first in the outfield and that aspect of his game will improve with experience...has a chance to be a very good player.

#### UNRATED PROSPECTS

**Mitchell Monas, C/OF, 5-11 155, Waynesburg HS, L/R**

Started as a freshman...strong arm and a team player...7.2 60 time...2.1 pop...batted .310...excellent student...3.9 GPA...looks to have excellent potential...swings the bat well.

**Brandon Wyvratt, P/OF, 5-11 150, Ringgold HS, R/R**

Young player with excellent potential...throws in the low 80s...7.2 60...pitched 18 innings as a freshman and registered 38 Ks while walking 11 and had a 4-1 record...3.0 GPA...also plays outfield.

With each graduation class, players are listed in four categories: 1) players who are NCAA "High" Division I prospects; 2) players who are NCAA "Lower" Division I prospects; 3) players who are NCAA Division II or Division III prospects and 4) players whose high school coach did not provide a rating. I did not include NAIA in any of the group descriptions only because I leave it to the NAIA coaches to decide their level of NCAA equivalency.

Players who have been added to the prospect list since the June issue are highlighted in **bold print**. In addition, any players who have had any information (such as height, weight or high school) updated will have the updated information only shown in **bold**. Please remember that WEST PENN BASEBALL PROSPECTS has not independently scouted these players. The ratings shown are based largely on the recommendations of area high school coaches.
